- The goals of the open models movement are similar to those of other open movements such as *open source*, *open hardware*, *open content*, *open data*, *open science*, and *open access*



#### The answer

Why? In contrast to the tremendous propagation of open source in software development, an analog paradigm does not seem to gain comparable momentum in modeling

#### Answer

- A repository of models will increase the productivity
- A low level of patters will make difficult the work
- A higher level of patters may endanger the enterprise privacy
